On September 27th, 2010, the 17th Annual Nordic Cup Golf Tournament will be held at the Rio Hondo Golf Club in Downey, CA. **This tournament is part of a fundraising event for The Norwegian Seaman's Church in San Pedro and Nansen Field in Palos Verdes.**

First established in 1941, **The Norwegian Seaman's Church** in San Pedro, CA, is the most important meeting place for Scandinavians in Southern California with about 20,000 visitors each year. With only wages to the employees paid from Norway and Sweden, the existence of the church is dependent entirely on local donations and fundraising.

Nansen Field was established in 1949 as a soccer field for visiting seamen. **SCAN (Scandinavian Center at Nansen Field)** was formed in May 1997 and embarked on the ambitious endeavor of establishing a Scandinavian Heritage, Cultural and Sports Center at Nansen Field. SCAN is responsible for preserving, maintaining and operating Nansen Field and its facilities and plays a vital role in fulfilling the cultural, athletic, educational and social needs of the Nordic community and others in Southern California.
